"Skyline" might be a stretch.



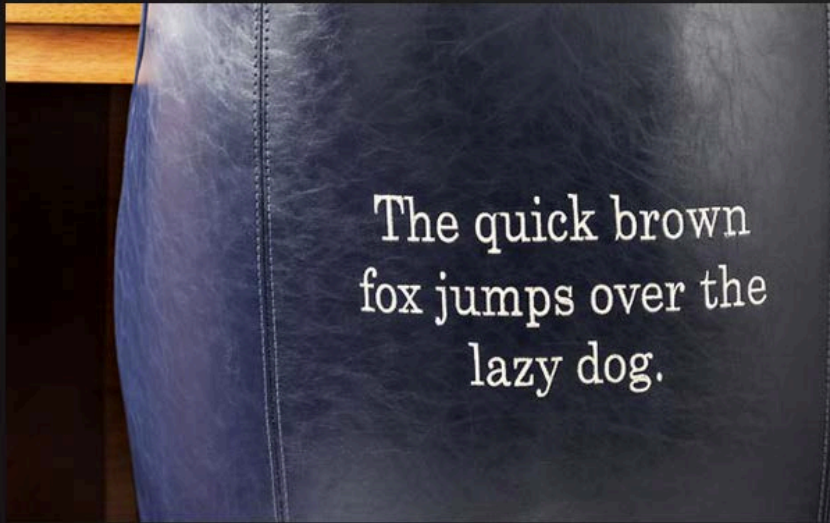
